Communities throughout Georgia are still assessing the damage from Hurricane Helene. Since making landfall, Hurricane Helene has caused catastrophic flooding and torrential rainfall, leading to dozens of fatalities and leaving millions without power.

As the State of Georgia begins to assess the damage, I urge you to issue guidance to work constructively with borrowers experiencing difficulties beyond their control because of damage caused by Hurricane Helene. This includes encouraging the financial institutions you regulate to temporarily waive penalties and fees against customers who may have limited access to their bank accounts or a limited ability to pay bills and other obligations because of damage caused by Hurricane Helene.

Thank you for your prompt attention to this urgent matter. I look forward to working with you to support Georgia and all surrounding areas affected by this disaster. By working together, we can assist Georgians on their road to recovery and strengthen the resiliency of their communities.
